



## How to get there

Most people travel to Stavanger by air. It is also possible to reach Stavanger by train, bus or car.

### By air

The airport of Stavanger, Sola, is situated 15 km from the city centre. The airport offers daily connections to various airports in Europe, such as London, Copenhagen, Amsterdam and Frankfurt. In addition, there are frequent departures to Norwegian cities such as Oslo, Bergen, Trondheim and Kristiansand. More information and schedules are available on:

There are airport buses between Sola International Airport and Stavanger city centre every 20 minutes. A ticket costs NOK 70 (ca 7.3 EUR or GBP) one way. ([www.flybussen.no](http://www.flybussen.no)) A taxi ride from the airport to the city will take ca 20 minutes and cost ca 300 NOK (ca 32 EUR or GBP).

### By train

Stavanger Railway station is situated in the centre of Stavanger, opposite of the bus terminal, Byterminal. It offers regular service between Stavanger and Oslo. The journey takes approximately eight hours. In addition, there are frequent departures to Kristiansand, a journey of approximately three hours.
