A Visit to the Norwegian Petroleum Museum, Saturday 06.09.08

On the way to the **Petroleum Museum** we pass **the Ledaal Manor** which is now used as a residence for royalty when visiting Stavanger, and **Breidablikk**, the best preserved mansion house in the country, dating from 1880s and with authentic interior.

The Norwegian Petroleum Museum opened in 1999 and has become a very popular interactive museum where you can study several areas of the petroleum industry: geology and technology; the excitement and drama of the oil adventure; how life is on board for workers on the oilrig; oil as a financial resource; and the social consequences of oil operations.

After the visit at the Petroleum Museum we drive along **Hafersfjord** and pass the monument **”The Three Swords”**, the symbol of the unification of Norway into one kingdom, in the year 872.

The tour ends at Sola Airport.
