

Animal that Comes after Animal. The Challenge of the Transpecies.

Anthropocene is not only a dramatic biological crisis but also a serious ontological, semiotic and political crisis. It refers not only to the loss of biodiversity but also to a main reconfiguration of what it means to be alive. In that way, it is actually the passing from one geological area to another one and could not be evaluated only in term of "loss". I wish to discuss that question through the notion of "transpecies" – living beings that do not belong to any species or that inhabit their own species in new ways.
