


Deposit and BankAxept card for Self-financing non-EU/EEA students:

The international students from non-EU/EEA countries who have transferred a deposit to the University of Stavanger in the process of getting a study permit can access this money shortly after arriving in Stavanger through a bank card called BankAxept. This is a temporary solution until you have opened your own bank account in Norway. As soon as you have opened your bank account we can transfer the rest of the money to your account.

How to obtain the card:

Cards are distributed by Student Information Desk in Arne Rettedals (AR) building after signing a form. It is personal attendance (no one else can pick up the card for you) and in order to get your card and PIN you need to bring:

- Passport
- Your Norwegian address
- 50 000 NOK will be transferred into the card
- The money will be available in the card within 3-4 days
- You can check your balance and movements at www.smn.no/utbetalingskort (available in Norwegian only)

With the BankAxept card it is possible to:

- Withdraw cash in any ATM (5000 NOK/hour or 10000 NOK/week)
- Pay in stores with payment terminals marked BankAxept in Norway

Fees

- NOK 125 for issuing BankAxept cash (automatically charged from your account)
- NOK 35 for transferring the money from the card to another account in Norway

Secure card use

- Read through the terms and conditions
 - Sign on the back of the card
 - Learn the PIN by heart; do not keep your PIN together with your card
 - If your card/PIN is lost or stolen, report it immediately. You cannot re-order your PIN-code.
 - Never let anyone know your PIN, including the police and the bank
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Open a bank account

Step 1 - Register with the police (Pre-book an appointment with the Stavanger police online <https://selfservice.udi.no/>)

- Residence card is sent to you after approx. 2 weeks
- Important: correct postal address and your name on letter box
- At the same time the police will give notice to the Tax administration that you need a ID number. This letter will arrive after about 2 weeks

Step 2 – open bank account

- Any bank can be used
 - Bring passport, document with your ID-number and residence card
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Once you have your bank account and want the rest of the money transferred to your account

- Go to AR-building and Student Information Desk (Not the International Office!)
- Fill in the form «*Deposit transfer to Norwegian bank account*»

The name of your new bank

Your bank account number

Your application number

Your passport

- The remaining sum in UiS' deposit account will be transferred to your bank account

Important:

- *Only* UiS can load your card with money – no other transfers to this account will be possible
- The card *cannot* be used for online purchases
- The card can be used in ATM's and payment terminals marked BankAxept only in Norway
- The card cannot be used as ID
- It is *not* possible to transfer money from the BankAxept card to another account. For this reason, if you decide to leave Norway, you need to empty the card before leaving. This also means that it is not possible to transfer money from your card to your own bank account.
