
## Practical information

- O Log in to StudentWeb and confirm study plan to keep place at UiS

- O Deadline: 1st February
- O You may withdraw 3 weeks prior to the first exam or the first mandatory assignment, depending on the course

# **Examination**

O Entitled to retake 3 exams

- Apply through StudentWeb after exam results have been published
- O Requirements for valid absence:
  - Illness (supported by doctor's note)
  - Failed ordinary exam
  - Withdrawal from ordinary exam



# **Academic misconduct**
