Rules for bachelor thesis at the Faculty of Science and Technology

Introduction

This document provides the rules for bachelor's thesis at the Faculty of Science and Technology, according to "Regulations on studies and examinations at the University of Stavanger".

We also refer to the "Guide for the bachelor's and master's thesis", which provides additional information about the rules, start-up, completion and submission of the thesis.

Deadlines

Bachelor's thesis of 10 credits (only applies to the "Lektorstudiet i Realfag")

- Within 1st December: students apply for or register their own thesis in the collaboration portal
- Within 15th December: the Faculty informs the students of the assigned thesis topic
- Within 10th January: the Faculty sends out a contract for the student(s) to sign
- Within 15th January: students' sign their contract in the collaboration portal
- 15th January: official start of the thesis
- Within 1st February: register for exam (StudentWeb)
- 1st April: deadline to withdraw from thesis
- 1st May: deadline for submitting application for confidentiality of your thesis
- 15th May: thesis submission deadline
- Within 3 weeks from the time of submission: exam result published

Bachelor thesis of 20 credits

- Within 1st December: students apply for or register their own thesis in the collaboration portal
- Within 15th December: the Faculty informs the students of the assigned thesis topic
- Within 10th January: the Faculty sends out a contract for the student(s) to sign
- Within 15th January: students' sign their contract in the collaboration portal
- 15th January: official start of the thesis
- Within 1st February: register for exam (StudentWeb)
- 1st April: deadline to withdraw from thesis
- 1st May: deadline for submitting application for confidentiality of your thesis
- 15th May: thesis submission deadline
- Within 4 weeks from the time of submission: exam result published

Credit requirements

10 and 20 credit assignment

To be allowed to start writing the thesis, the student must have passed a minimum of 100 credits according to the approved education plan, as well as having passed the prerequisites stated in the course description by 1st November.

Additional information about thesis writing

A maximum of three students can collaborate on a bachelor's thesis. Each student must sign their own contract, including those who write the thesis in a group.

Generally, a candidate has only one attempt submitting the thesis. It is possible to apply for a second attempt ref. "regulations on studies and examinations at the University of Stavanger" §3-10 point 4.

Postpone the submission deadline

Students can apply for an extended submission deadline in the event of valid absence. See "regulations on studies and examinations at the University of Stavanger" §3-12. Students that are abroad, and who have their last exam after the date of starting thesis writing, can apply for an extended submission deadline corresponding to the time lost.

Restricted publication (Confidentiality agreement)

Generally, the thesis must be open, but can, upon application, be restricted (postponed publication) for a maximum of 5 years. Students must clarify and, if necessary, apply for restricted publication already at the start of the thesis period.

Apply by sending "Agreement concerning Restricted access to Bachelor's or Master's thesis" together with a justified application from the company by e-mail to post-tn@uis.no. The deadline for submitting the Confidentiality Agreement is 1 May. Only the official faculty agreement should be used.

Assignment writing outside the ordinary exam-period

If you need to write the thesis in the autumn semester, it is possible to apply for this by submitting an "application for a change to the education plan at UiS" via Digital Student Expedition. Note that it is your responsibility to find a thesis topic and Supervisor

The application deadline is 15 June.

Note that: To be allowed to start writing the thesis, the student must have passed a minimum of 130 credits in accordance with the approved education plan, as well as having passed the prerequisites stated in the course description by 15 June

a document with the following must be attached to the application:

- Reason for wanting to change the period
- Confirmation from the Supervisor
- Topic/title for the thesis

Deadlines for thesis writing outside the ordinary period

- **Before 20 June:** registered thesis in the collaboration portal
- 15 August: official start of thesis writing
- **1 November** deadline for withdrawing from the examination
- **15 December:** submission deadline
