Erasmus+ documents

- O Learning Agreement
 - Must be signed by yourself and your home institution first
- O Confirmation of Arrival
 - Start date should be the date of your first activity
 - Cannot be earlier than the semester start (02.01.24)
- O Confirmation of Stay / Departure
 - End date should be the date of your final exam





Arrival registration


Nordic citizens:

EU/EEA and non-EU/EEA citizens:

You must make an appointment to register your arrival through the <u>UDI Application</u>

Tuberculosis test

- O Mandatory for all students coming from/having spent 3 months in high-risk areas/countries
- O International Office will soon send an invitation to a mandatory information meeting to all students who need to get tested
- O Important to show up for scheduled test appointments.

 The results will not affect your stay in Norway. Any treatment is free of charge
