

Internship at UiS in the NEB-STAR project

WHAT IS NEB-STAR?

The New European Bauhaus (NEB) is a creative and interdisciplinary EU initiative that connects the European Green Deal to our living spaces and experiences. Three values are set as core principles: SUSTAINABLE: from climate goals, to circularity, zero emissions and biological diversity. BEAUTIFUL: quality and style over functionality. INCLUSIVE: from valuing diversity, to ensuring accessibility and affordability.

[NEB-STAR](#) has been selected as one of six New European Bauhaus lighthouse demonstrators. The NEB-STAR project is funded by the EU over three years, for the period 2022-2025, and includes 16 partners. With NEB-STAR, we will change the way municipalities, business, citizens and other actors work together, in order to find fair and robust solutions to our climate and social challenges. Together, we work with social innovation to become climate neutral faster - in an inclusive, aesthetic and sustainable way.

In Stavanger we work in two test bed areas: Pedersgata and Site 4016. In the project, we both test and propose how inhabitants and other actors in society can be part of designing, influencing and carrying out the municipality's plans and missions.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

As an intern with UiS in NEB-STAR you will work with a team of researchers exploring new ways of involving inhabitants in co-creating better urban futures. Your precise role will depend on your field of study and your own interests. We will shape this role together. The internship will allow you to:

- ✓ Take part in organising and carrying out co-creation activities with engaged inhabitants.
- ✓ Experiment with new ways of creating better, more inclusive futures in a place-based manner.
- ✓ Use your own skill-set to make a difference in collaboration with experienced colleagues in a cross-disciplinary setting.
- ✓ Get ideas and inspiration for your master thesis (topics, methods, research questions, data material, etc.).
- ✓ Build networks for both the master thesis and your future career.
- ✓ Gain experience of working in a multi-partner EU-funded research and innovation project.

We welcome interns with backgrounds in change leadership, digital society, and energy, environment and society.
