


PRIVATE HOUSING MARKET





Create an Invoice on Student Web

- Log into your account on <u>Student Web</u>.
- Go to 'PAYMENTS' to create an invoice for the semester fee

Payment method option 1

- Pay via online banking
- Remember to include your name and application number in reference.



Payment method option 2

- Cash and credit card payments are not accepted on campus
- If you are not able to pay via online banking, you need to find somebody who can help you to pay this online.


- The app can be used as your student ID in Norway.
- The app replaces the previous physical student card and will give you access to the main buildings
- You need to upload a photo via konto.uis.no for it to appear in the 'Studentbevis' app.

- The semester receipt is your confirmation that you have paid the semester fee and are registered as a student at UiS. You can download the receipt in the app.

POLICE REGISTRATION

For non-EU/EEA students

- You are required to register in person at the local immigration office (Stavanger police station) within 7 days of your arrival in Norway.
- Book an appointment in the Norwegian Directorate of Immigration's (UDI) <u>Application portal</u>.
- After the police registration, you will receive a residence card and Norwegian ID number (also called national identity number) in the post. It can take up to 6-8 weeks after registration to receive them.
- Remember to register your correct postal address and name to your mailbox so the letter is delivered to you correctly.






SUA REGISTRATION

For EU/EEA students

- EU/EEA Citizens must register their stay within 3 months of their arrival
- If you have an electronic **ID** you can do this online
- If you do not have an electronic ID, you need to report a move on paper.
- All information about this process is available at <u>Skatteetaten's website</u>
- After the registration, you will receive a *Norwegian ID number* (also called *national identity number*) in the post. It can take up to **4-6 weeks** after registration to receive your Norwegian ID number in the post.
- Remember to register your correct postal address and name to your mailbox so the letter is delivered to you correctly.

BANKAXEPT CARD

OPENING A BANK ACCOUNT IN NORWAY RETURNING YOUR DEPOSIT VIA BANK TRANSFER

DEPOSIT AND KRONEKORT CARD

For non-EU/EEA students

Students from non-EU/EEA countries who have transferred a deposit to the University of Stavanger in the process of getting a study permit can access NOK 50 000 shortly after arriving in Stavanger through a bank card called a BankAxept card.

Further information about where and when you can pick up your BankAxept card will be sent out later.

- Please bring sufficient cash until you receive the money on your BankAxept card (2 – 3 weeks)
- This is a temporary solution until you have opened your own bank account in Norway. As soon as you have opened your bank account, we can transfer the rest of the money from the deposit account to your own account. The money on the card cannot be transferred.
- Therefore, students who transferred a deposit must open their own bank accounts in Norway.
- The card has a cost of 600 NOK and is voluntary.







Please note that nobody can pick up your BankAxept card except you. It will also take time for you to access the money on your BankAxept card. We advise you to bring enough money for the first two weeks of arrival in Stavanger.

HOW TO OPEN YOUR BANK ACCOUNT IN NOWAY

Once you have registered at the police station or SUA, you will be assigned a national identity number. This can take 6-10 weeks. Your national identity number is required when opening up a bank account in Norway.

After you have received your Norwegian ID number, go to any bank and bring the following documents to open your own account:

1

PASSPORT

Bring you passport as identification for opening your account 2

SKATTE ETATEN (TAX OFFICE) LETTER

This letter documents your national identity number given after you registered at the police station or SUA

RESIDENCE CARD

Your residence permit if you are from a non-EU/EEA country





RETURNING YOUR DEPOSIT TO YOUR NORWEGIAN BANK ACCOUNT

For non-EU/EEA students

- Once you have a Norwegian bank account, the remaining balance of your deposit can be transferred to your account.
- Go to the Admissions office (2nd floor Kitty Kielland's building) with your passport and fill out a form called: "Deposit Transfer to Norwegian Bank Account"
- This must be done in person by the student for identification purposes. You will need the following information to fill out the form:

- Bank Name

BACHELOR'S DIPLOMA & TRANSCRIPTS VERIFICATION

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

All international students need to bring their original documents to be verified upon arrival in Stavanger

You will receive an email in September with instructions to present your documents for verification Remember to bring the following original documents with you to Stavanger:



BACHELOR'S DIPLOMA /CERTIFICATE



BACHELOR'S TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS



Do not show up without an appointment



If you fail to present your original documentation, your study rights at UiS may be revoked



If your documents are not in English, Norwegian, Danish or Swedish – you need to bring the official translations accompanying your documents.

YOUR HEALTH

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

People from countries with a high occurrence of tuberculosis are obliged to undergo tuberculosis testing if they intend to stay more than three months in Norway.

For students from a high endemic country

See the list of countries with high and very high occurrences of TB from the Norwegian Institute of Public Health

People from high endemic countries and/or have stayed in one of those countries for more than 3 months

Within 4 weeks after arrival in Norway

You will be invited to a meeting with the Office of Infection Control (Smittevernkontoret) on campus where you will receive more information about when you can be tested.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Look into insurance options and bring the relevant documents with you to Stavanger.

Students staying in Norway for more than one year automatically become insured under the <u>Norwegian National Insurance Scheme</u> once they receive a Norwegian ID number (fødselsnummer). Please note that it can take up to 2-3 months before you receive a Norwegian ID number.

The Norwegian National Insurance Scheme is not a travel insurance. It does not cover any loss or damage to persons or property that might occur during your stay. Therefore, we urge all students to insure their household contents during their stay in Norway. Theft and burglary in student dormitories may occur.
