

Regulations related to tuition fee at the University of Stavanger

The regulations apply to students covered by Section 2-6 of the Universities and University Colleges Act and are intended to regulate matters relating to tuition fees that are not already governed by the Regulations relating to Studies and Examinations at UiS.

NOTE: This English version of the regulation is provided for informational purposes only. In the event of any discrepancy between the English and Norwegian versions, the Norwegian version shall prevail.

1. Tuition Fees

- 1.1 Students covered by [Section 2-6, first paragraph of the Universities and University Colleges Act](#) shall pay the prescribed tuition fee within the prescribed deadline. Students who fail to pay the tuition fee may lose their right to study, cf. [Examination Regulations Section 3-2](#).
- 1.2 Students shall pay for the degree to which they are admitted. Students enrolled in single courses shall pay for the courses to which they are admitted.
- 1.3 Within the prescribed deadlines and in the prescribed manner, students may apply for an exemption from payment of the tuition fee, cf. [Section 2-6, second paragraph of the Universities and University Colleges Act](#).

2. Prices

- 2.1 Tuition fees are adjusted annually. New prices apply to both new and continuing students.

3. Change in the Study Plan

- 3.1 No additional payment is required for changes made to the study plan within the same period of study right, cf. [Examination Regulations Section 3-3](#). In the case of new admission, a new fee must be paid.
- 3.2 No additional payment is required for supplementary courses to which the student registers.
- 3.3 The inclusion of external courses in the study plan does not result in a reduction of the prescribed tuition fee.

4. Exchange Programmes

- 4.1 Tuition fees shall be paid as normal when a student participates in an outbound exchange. Should the host university also require payment, this will be in addition.

5. Termination from Studies

- 5.1 Termination from studies entails the laps of future payment obligations.

6. Refund

- 6.1 Students may apply for a refund in the following cases:
 - a) In the event of rejection of an application for a study permit
 - b) Upon approval of an application for exemption from tuition fees or for leave of absence
 - c) In the event of withdrawal from, or termination of, studies or courses
 - d) In cases of matters or errors attributable to UiS, where it would be unreasonable to impose costs on the student
 - e) In exceptional cases where compelling reasons warrant it
- 6.2 Applications for refunds must be submitted in the prescribed manner within the semester registration deadline.
- 6.3 Applications submitted after the semester registration deadline may provide grounds for a refund in the subsequent semester.
- 6.4 The right to a refund may lapse if the student has exhibited improper conduct.

7. Regulations

- 7.1 The rights and obligations pursuant to the [Regulations relating to Studies and Examinations at UiS](#) and in the [Universities and University Colleges Act](#) apply accordingly to students covered by this regulation.
