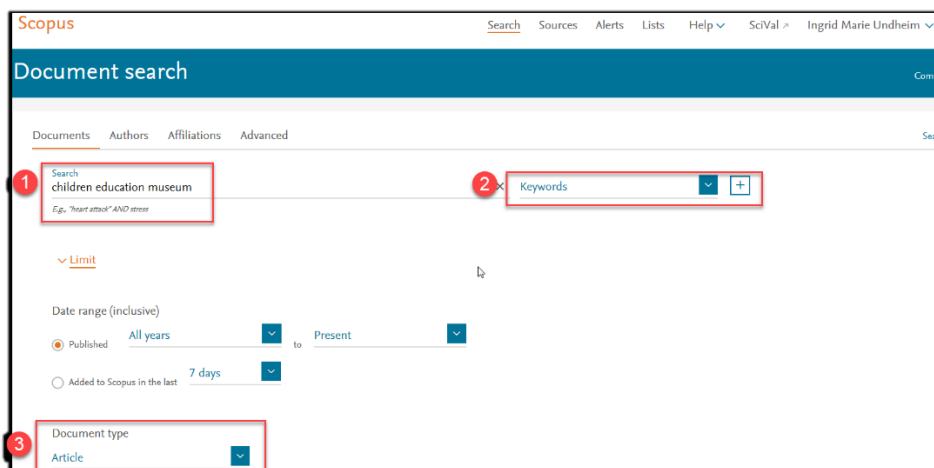
Nedenfor finner du fremgangsmåte for hvordan du kan sette opp slike varslinger i de tre største tidsskriftdatabasene våre: **Scopus**, **ScienceDirect** eller **Academic Search Premium**. Vi anbefaler å prøve Scopus først.

Første gang du skal sette opp varsling i en database må du opprette en bruker med brukernavn (email) og passord.

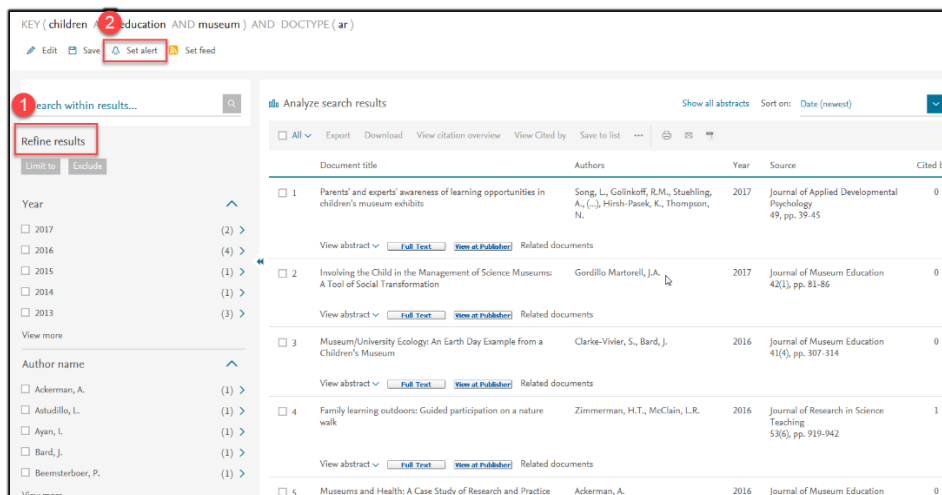
Ta kontakt med oss på biblioteket dersom du trenger hjelp til å sette opp emnesøk.

Scopus

1. Skriv først aktuelle emneord. Tenk gjennom hvilke emneord du bruker. Kanskje kan det være synonymer til ordene du bruker.
2. Velg **Article title**, **abstracts**, **keywords** i nedtrekksmenyen.
3. Dokumenttype kan avgrenses om du får mange treff, men vi anbefaler å prøve først uten.
4. Trykk **Search**

2. Velg **Set alert** dersom du ønsker varsling når det kommer nye artikler innenfor dette søket.
